Public Notice: Impact of Federal Government Shutdown

Due to the ongoing Federal Government Shutdown, operations at the Quartz Valley Indian Reservation have been affected.

To manage resources effectively, the Tribe has temporarily reduced employee work hours to 32 hours per week.

At present, Tribal offices will continue to operate on their regular schedule, with staff adjusting their hours to maintain service availability. We appreciate your patience and understanding, as you may experience longer wait times for services. Should the shutdown extend into November, further reductions including office closures will be necessary with further reductions in staff hours.

The Anav Tribal Health Clinic will remain open with no reductions at this time.

Current Operational Changes:

- The gym is closed to the public, except for pre-scheduled events primarily organized by Anav Tribal Health Clinic staff.
- The Enrollment Office is not staffed. However, enrollment documents may be submitted to Kayla Super or Sheila Casey.
- The Fire Hall is not staffed. For inquiries related to fire services, please contact the Tribal Administrator directly.
